# OUR ACHIEVEMENTS ON SDG'S

SDG# 16: We have launched Global Peace Campaign from Pakistan while providing International Peace City Key to Deputy Mayor of Islamabad.

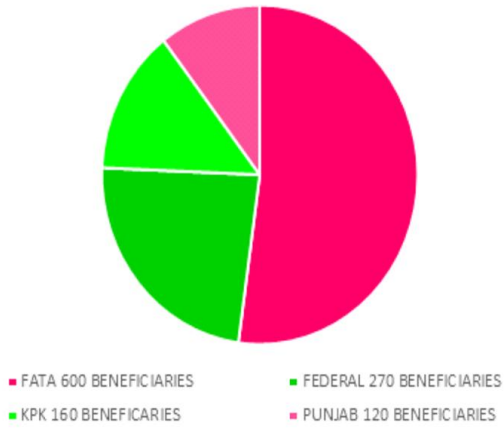

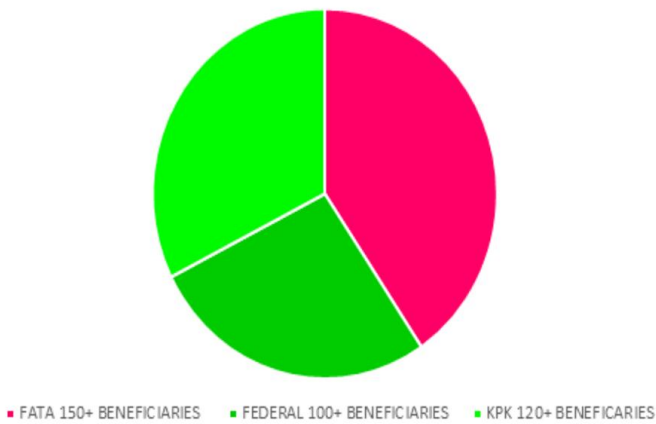

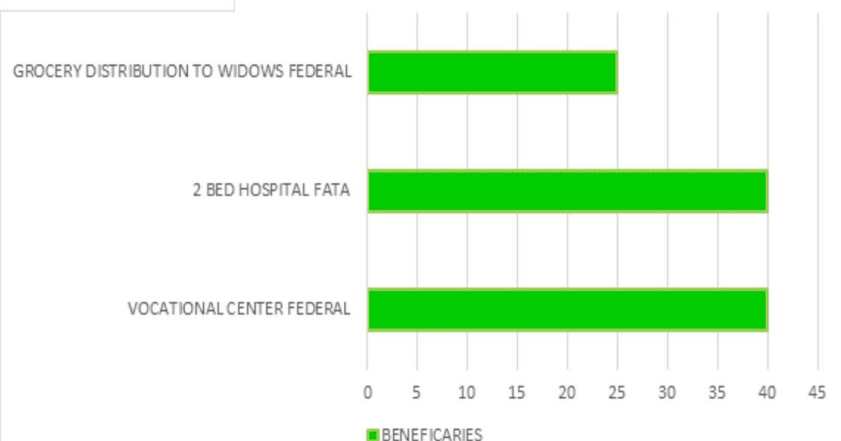

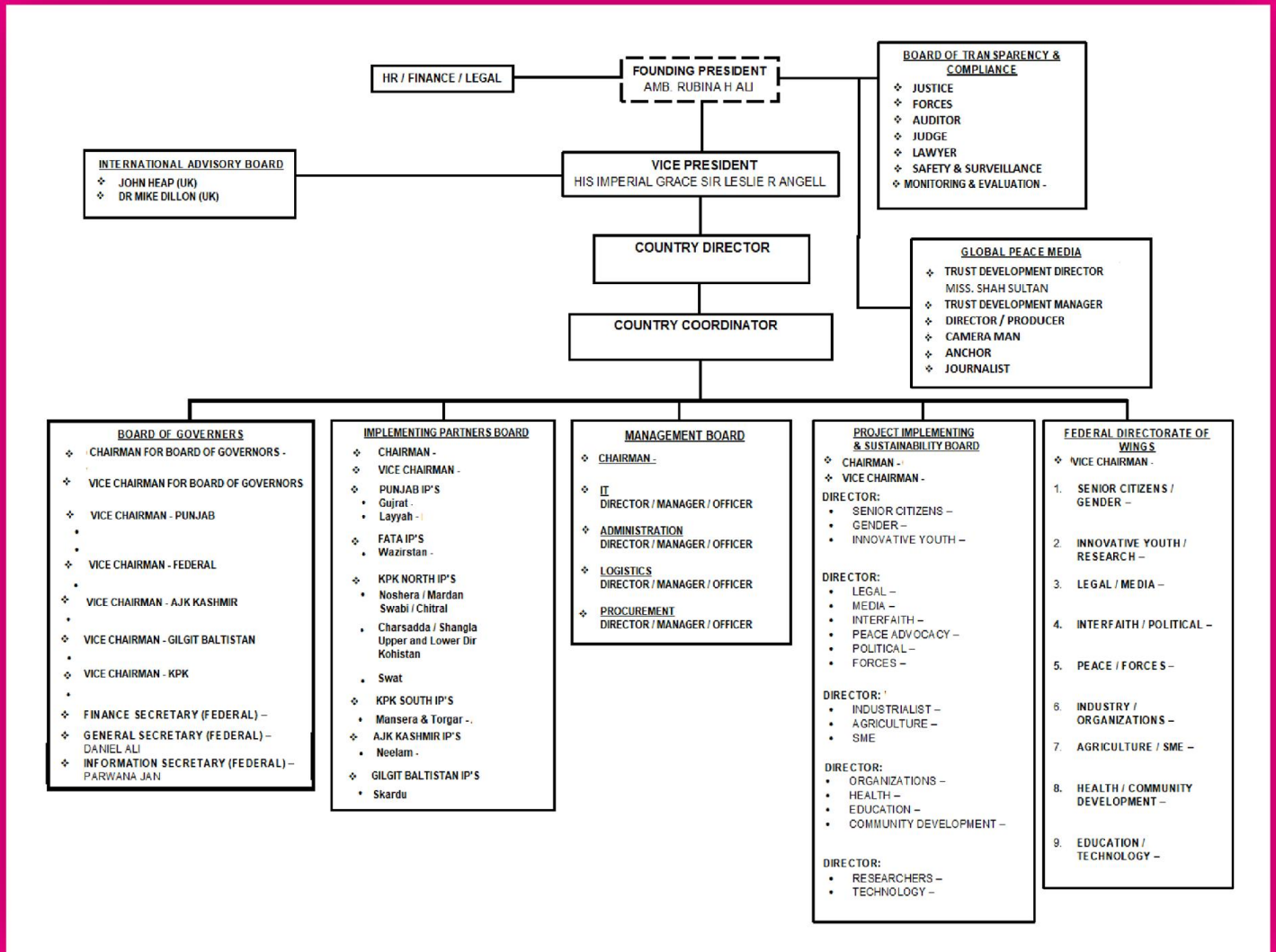
